2019 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Information and application packet for the Northwest Chemical Association Lottery Scholarship Awards. Please complete the details on page 3 and return to NWCA Board.

LOTTERY AWARDS

Two awards of \$1,500.00 each will be given out yearly.

Four people will be chosen: Two award winners and two alternates.

The awards will be selected by random drawing at the Spring (May) meeting and checks will be issued in July of the same year.

NOMINATIONS

One nomination per eligible member (as defined in the by-laws) shall be entered in the lottery drawing. A student may not be chosen two consecutive years.

Any NWCA member whose dues are current can nominate one student who fits into either of the following categories:

Category I:

Students who are blood relatives or legal dependents of a member, and who meet eligibility requirements.

Category II:

Any student who fits the eligibility requirements

The Scholarship Chairman and the Treasurer of the Northwest Chemical Association will verify those nominated.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible students include:

- 1) High school seniors with a minimum GPA of 2.75 who are entering their freshman year at an accredited college or university;



- 2) College students with a minimum GPA of 2.75 who are enrolled in a full time curriculum (12 hours minimum), are in good academic standing and will enroll in a full time curriculum the coming school year (fall). This includes graduate students with at least one full academic year to be completed.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. **Deadline:** The Chairperson of the NWCA Scholarship Committee must receive nominations no later than May 1st.
2. Two students from each category will be chosen at the NWCA Spring meeting in a random lottery drawing. The first name selected in each category will be the winner of the award and the second two names will be the alternates. The scholarship committee will notify all four students no later than July 1st.
3. By July 1st, winners of the Lottery Awards are required to supply to the Scholarship Committee written notification from the college or university that he/she attends, that he/she is in good academic standing, and will be enrolled for the next school year. Those Lottery winners who are high school seniors or college seniors must submit to the Scholarship Committee written certification that he/she will be matriculated in a college or university's undergraduate or graduate degree program for the coming school year.

Once this criterion is met, the Northwest Chemical Association will then issue a check for \$1,500.00 in both the students and the school names.

Note: If a Lottery winner is not able to claim his or her award by July 15th, that award will be awarded to the alternate. If the alternate is unable to claim his or her award, that award will not be issued and the funds will remain undistributed.

A student may not win the award in two consecutive years.
